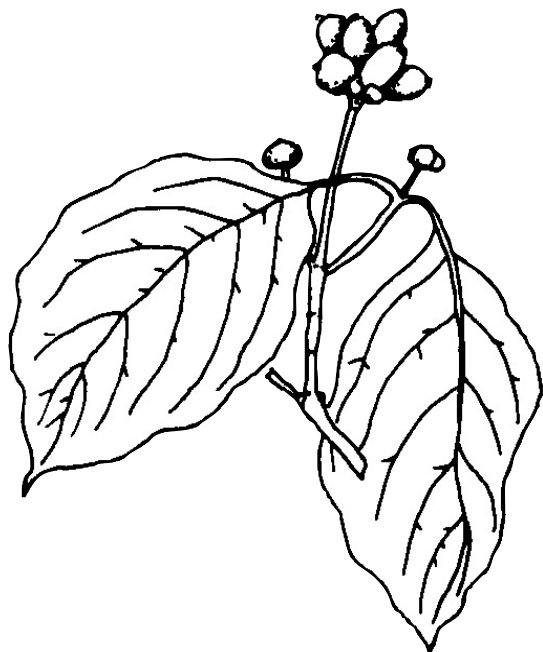

WHITE FLOWERING DOGWOOD *Cornus florida*



The **white flowering dogwood** is an excellent landscape choice for all four seasons. White petal-like bracts show their beauty in spring, foliage turns a vibrant red-purple in fall, and glossy red fruits attract winter songbirds for the enjoyment of all.

The seeds, fruits, flowers, twigs, bark, and leaves are all used as food by various animals. At least 36 species of birds — including ruffed grouse, bobwhite quail, and wild turkey — are known to eat the fruit. Chipmunks, foxes, squirrels, skunks, rabbits, deer, beaver, black bear, and other mammals also eat the fruit. Foliage and twigs are browsed heavily by deer and rabbits.
