

Tree Descriptions

Sargent Crabapple grows slowly to 6'-10' tall with a 6'-12' spread that exceeds its height. Profuse clusters of small, white, fragrant flowers in the spring are followed by 1/3"-1/2" red berries that persist into winter. Birds love the fruit. New leaves are light green, later turning a darker green.

American Redbud grows at a medium rate to 20'-30' tall with a 30' spread. Small, rosy pink spring flowers are followed by reddish-purple-tinged leaves that gradually change to a lustrous green in summer and a striking yellow in fall. The shiny reddish-brown 2"-3" seed pods remain on the tree throughout winter.

Washington Hawthorn grows at a medium rate to 25'-30' tall with a 25' spread. White late spring flowers are followed by 1/4" glossy red fruits that stay on the tree into winter. Leaves are reddish-purple when emerging, changing to dark green in summer, then to orange, scarlet, or purple in fall. The slender stems have thorns. *This tree has a high wildlife value.*

Arrowwood Viburnum grows fast to 6'-15' tall with an equal spread. A multi-stemmed dense shrub, it has creamy white late spring or early summer flowers followed by 1/4" blue-black berries that ripen in early fall. Dark green leaves in summer will vary in color from yellow to glossy red to reddish-purple in the fall. This shrub provides food, cover, and nesting sites for birds and larval food for butterflies and moths.


