# ARROWWOOD VIBURNUM Viburnum dentatum

1 Washington Hawthorn (Crataegus phaenopyrum)



### Number of trees: 2 Paint color: PINK

A multi-stemmed dense shrub, it has white late spring or early summer flowers followed by 1/4" blue-black berries that ripen in early fall. Dark green leaves in summer will vary in color from yellow to red to reddish-purple in fall.

# BUR OAK Quercus macrocarpa



### Number of trees: 1 Paint color: NO PAINT

After 35 years, it produces fringed acorns ¾"-1½" long and ¾"-2" in diameter. Leaves are dark green in summer, turning dull tan in winter. This oak provides food and shelter for a wide variety of birds and animal life.

# **COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE** *Picea pungens*



### Number of trees: 1 Paint color: LIGHT BLUE

Silvery or blue-green needles are 1"-1½" in length. After 20 years, 2½"-4" cones develop. Plant 8'-12' apart for a windbreak.

## GRAY DOGWOOD Cornus racemosa



### Number of trees: 1 Paint color: SILVER

A dense multi-stemmed shrub with white late spring flowers followed by ¼" white berries that ripen in late summer or early fall. The leaves are gray-green to dark green in summer, turning purplish-red in fall.

Growth Rate	Slow (less than 12" per year)
Sun Preference	Full Sun, Partial Shade, Full Shade
Soil Preference	Drought-tolerant

# RED OAK Quercus rubra



### Number of trees: 1 Paint color: RED

Produces 34"-1" acorns after 25 years. The leaves are a shiny rich green color in summer turning russet red to bright red in the fall.

Mature Canopy Spread	45'
Growth Rate	Fast (25" or more per year)
Sun Preference	Full Sun
Soil Preference	Acidic, Clay, Drought-tolerant, Loamy, Moist, Sandy, Well-drained

# RIVER BIRCH Betula nigra



### Number of trees: 1 Paint color: GOLD

It has cinnamon-colored exfoliating bark and lustrous medium green leaves in summer that turn a soft yellow in fall. It likes to be near water but can adapt.

Growth Rate	Medium (13"-24" per year) to Fast (25" or more

# SARGENT CRABAPPLE Malus sargentii



### Number of trees: 1 Paint color: PURPLE

Profuse clusters of small, white, fragrant flowers in spring are followed by ½" red berries that persist into winter and attract birds. New leaves are light green, later turning a darker green.

Mature Canopy Spread	6'-12'
Growth Rate	Slow (less than 12" per year)
Sun Preference	Full Sun
Soil Preference	Acidic or Alkaline, Moist, Well-drained

# TULIPTREE Liriodendron tulipifera



### Number of trees: 1 Paint color: WHITE

Bright green leaves with aromatic stems change to golden yellow in fall. In spring, large, cup-shaped, greenish-yellow flowers attract ruby-throated hummingbirds, while squirrels and birds are drawn to the tuliptree's seeds.

# WASHINGTON HAWTHORN Crataegus phaenopyrum



### Number of trees: 1 Paint color: YELLOW

White spring flowers are followed by ¼" red fruits that stay on the tree into winter. Thorny stems produce reddish-purple leaves that change to dark green in summer, then to orange, scarlet, or purple in fall. This tree has a high wildlife value.
