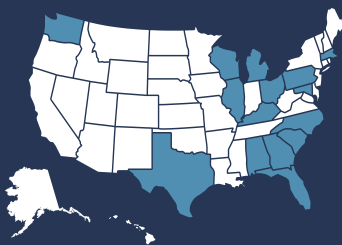

In Grand Rapids, Michigan, **Spectrum Health Blodgett Hospital** and **Friends of Grand Rapids Parks** planted three oak trees in the initial phase of a Survivors Grove of Trees. This grove is located at a community park and honors those who have beat cancer.

Tanner Medical Center maintains a 20+ acre walking trail and park in Carrollton, Georgia — a space the community is encouraged to enjoy. And when the hospital opened a new facility in 2019, tree education was incorporated into the landscape. Each tree has a sign with the genus and common name printed to help educate the public as they walk through the garden.
